

ENGLISH

We will introduce The Curious Quest and through this we will be consolidating our sentence writing by

- starting sentences with capital letters
- including finger spaces between each word
- Ending sentences using full stops or question marks.
- Extending sentences uses 'and'

We will be learning new vocabulary (with actions) to help make our writing more exciting! We will be learning the difference between fiction and non-fiction texts and begin to look at poetry.

MATHS

We will be learning

- place value of numbers up to 20 and how to partition these numbers into tens and ones.
- to rote count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- to consolidate skills of addition and subtraction using resources and the number line.
- to form numerals 0-9 in the right direction.
- To read and write numerals as words.

SCIENCE

We will be continuing with our learning about animals.. We will be

- identifying and naming common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identify and name animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Describing and comparing the structure of a variety of common animals.



GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about and to locate

- the United Kingdom.
- the four countries of the UK.
- the capital cities of the UK
- Seas around the UK

We will also be learning about the difference between human and physical features.
