We are writing to let you know about an upcoming visit that has been planned for the year 5 children at Skegness Grammar School, on Friday 26th April.

Throughout the day, the children will be taking part in a Harry Potter themed curriculum day, including a potions lesson (chemistry), Quidditch practise (P.E), and some music.

The children may also have the opportunity to do reptile handling. The animals are used to being handled, however they can carry salmonella and so we will ensure that everyone washes their hands with antibacterial soap after handling. If do not wish your child to take part in this specific part of the day, please indicate below, on the permission slip.

This will be an excellent opportunity for the children to experience a day in secondary school, and to see how it differs from a day in primary school, and will be an important step to helping ensure as smooth as possible transition, irrespective of the school that they will be attending for their secondary education. During the visit the children will accompanied at all times by staff from Beacon Primary Academy.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch, a drink, a coat, and suitable footwear.
