Please complete Monday's and Tuesday's English first (30.3.20 and 31.3.20)

This is a two day task:

Please complete your planning on day one (Wednesday 1.4.20) then writing on day two (Thursday 2.4.20).

Pretend that you are Julius Caesar. You are going to plan and write three diary entries from his point of view as a 16 year old, as a soldier and then as a ruler of Rome. Think about everything that you know about him. Use the table below to add ideas about the 3 times of his life, what happened and his thoughts and feelings. Remember to think of your Tier 2 vocabulary from our working wall!

(Remember, you can't write the diary after he'd died, as he wouldn't be alive to write it but you could include clues to what happened before it.)
