

ENGLISH

We will be consolidating the skills of starting sentences with capital letters, including finger spaces between each word and ending sentences with the correct punctuation (. ! ?)

We will be extending our writing using 'and' and begin to write simple stories. We will be using a different text each week to support us with these skills, including non-fiction texts and writing instructions.

In phonics we will continue learning new level 5 graphemes and continue to consolidate our blending skills.

We will continue to consolidate our handwriting skills and continue to focus on the Curly Caterpillar Family letters from last term and build up on forming the letters *f*, *q* and *o* correctly.

MATHS

Our topics will be

Multiplication- we will learn to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10 along with being able to recognise equal groups, add equal groups together, make equal groups and share into equal groups.

Fractions- we will be learning to find half and quarter of shapes and quantities.

We will also consolidate our knowledge of numbers to 50, form numbers the correct way around as well as learning to read and spell numbers as words.

SCIENCE

We will be learning to identify plants and their features, name trees and their parts, learn that plants come from seeds and bulbs, and what plants need to grow.

We will work scientifically by observing, classifying, making predictions and raising questions about plants and responding to suggestions of how to set up an investigation.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning what human and physical features are and how to locate them on an aerial photograph. We will be learning to draw symbols on a sketch map. We will learn about the UK and Europe and compare this to China and Asia. We will also consolidate our understanding of compass points.
