Year Intent



In Year 1, children begin to develop an early understanding of technology and how it forms part of everyday life.

They explore their ideas about devices such as computers and tablets and consider how technology can be used in helpful ways.

Pupils learn that the same kindness and respect shown in real life should also apply when using technology. They also begin to understand who they can ask for help if something worries them.
