### Topic Theme: Aiming High

Our class is called the **Geologists** which links with our Science topic about rocks (and other topics later in the year) so we will be finding out more about that particular career this year. Our theme of Aiming High will be taught through all subjects including Building Futures sessions based on 'everyday skills'.

  - Reading information about Climate Zones (Geography)
- Maths

  - Addition and subtraction to 100
  - Multiplication using times tables 2, 3, 5 and 10
