
Honestly, this school is superb. Each member of staff is so warm and welcoming and feel I am very blessed in being able to send my 2 boys to this school

Reading at Beacon

- ☐ Children in Reception start to work through the Twinkl Phonics Programme until Year 2.
- Children bring home reading books that match their ability level every week.
- □At Beacon we expect all children to read at home 5 times or more.
- Parent/carers can attend a phonics workshop in term 1 to learn how to support their child at home.

- ☐ All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Free School Meals.
- Variety of hot and cold options to select of our school menu.
- □Children who do not want a FSM will need to provide their child with their own packed lunch.




- ☐ Primary school admissions
